

PROTECTED AREAS STRATEGY CRUNCHER

FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

CUT ALONG DOTTED LINE

1. Put the side with the PAS logos down.

Fold two corners together to make a triangle, and crease firmly. Unfold, then fold the other two corners together to make a triangle going the other way and crease again. Unfold.

2. Again, put the side with the PAS logo down.

Fold two corners together towards the centre so that they meet in the middle of the paper and crease firmly. Leave them there. Now do the same with the other two corners.

3. Flip over so that the PAS logos are down again.

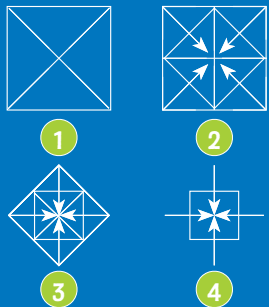
Again fold two corners together so that they meet in the centre of the paper, give a good crease. Do the same with the other two corners.

4. Flip over so that the PAS logos are up.

Fold half in one direction, then in half in the other direction.

5. Finally... stick your thumbs and first two fingers into the four pockets under the PAS logos and start crunching.
